- Approve the annual financial estimates (budget) and financial statements of the Institute.
- Approve the recommendations regarding the students' and employees' welfare activities in the Institute.
- Taking note of inspection reports, local inquiry reports, audit reports, of NAAC/NBA, etc. and approval to actions if any.

Academic Council

Academic Council is the Apex body of Ideal College of Law for its academic activities. It is headed by the Principal and all Head of the Departments are its members. It meets at regular intervals to discuss the academic programs of the university and the academic activities of the institute. - E.** Recommend to the Governing Council the scholarships, studentships, fellowships, prizes, and medals, and to frame regulations for the award of the same.
- F.** Advise the Governing Council on suggestions(s) pertaining to academic affairs made by it.
- G.** Perform such other functions as may be assigned by the Governing Council.
